Traffic Guidelines

As our school is situated in a residential area, the efficient flow of traffic around the Square and pedestrian access to pavements is of great importance. We have clear systems in place for dismissal and morning drop off times, designed to ensure that our school community, and also our neighbours with whom we share the Square, remain safe.

Please see guidelines below:

- If travelling by car in the morning, all drivers must follow the one-way system. The school should be approached by the Moscow Road (Bayswater) side only, so that you can draw up and let your daughter out on the school side.
- Leave Pembridge Square by driving in a clockwise direction (see map).
- Staff members on traffic duty will be on the pavement outside school to take girls to the school steps.
- Where possible, parents should endeavour to park further away from the school and walk to drop your daughter off and to collect her. This also applies to taxis and drivers.
- Do not park outside either school building as it causes huge congestion around the whole Square.
- Do not park in a **No Parking** zone. Signs are placed on the pavements that indicate these areas.
- We encourage families who live nearby to walk with your daughter to school. Please be aware that we have a scooter park at both buildings.
- On the pavements, parents should strive to keep a pathway clear for our neighbours to walk through and should not sit on the walls of our neighbours.
- To help reduce air pollution, car engines should not be left running when parked on the Square.

**The yellow lines outside numbers 18 and 10 are for drop-off only.
The yellow line on the far side of the road outside number 18 should be kept clear at all times.**
