Each girl is taught by enthusiastic, able professionals who extend and develop each child no matter what her level of interest or ability. Fixtures are arranged to include as many girls as possible, however, this is also dependent upon the number of teams other schools may have. Our policy regarding selection is unashamedly by ability, in order to ensure that girls of certain ability will play against similarly able girls at other schools.

The girls' are assessed at the beginning of every season and then throughout the term. Every child's prospects are taken seriously and girls will always be invited to squad training if we feel they have potential.

Team selection and management at any level is the direct responsibility of the member of staff running the team. Parents may, of course, discuss their daughter's progress at any time with the head of PE.
